Tuition:

Two-day workshop July 8-9 is \$275 (Early Bird Price before May 30th is \$250).

Three-day workshop that can apply to certification, July 8-10 is \$400 (Early Bird Price before May 30th is \$350).

Cancellation Policy: Cynde Van Vleet reserves the right to cancel a session due to circumstances beyond her control or if enrollment is deemed insufficient. In this case all tuition will be refunded.

Participant Cancellation Policy: For cancellation notice received more than 30 days in advance of the training, a refund will be given less a 25% handling fee. For cancellation notifications within 30 days of the training, a 25% handling fee will be retained and the balance will be credited toward another TTouch workshop within one year.

Animals Attending the Workshop: Dogs are welcome to accompany you to the training for as many days of the class as you wish, but **you must let us know in advance at the time you register because we limit the number of dogs who can participate.** To do so, please [download](#) and print out the Animal Profile Form, fill it out, then scan and [email](#) to the workshop instructor. (Note: Do not send these forms to the TTouch office.) If there is a question about your dog, the instructor will contact you. Otherwise, assume that he or she may attend.

If your dog will be attending, bring:

- Crate, x-pen, or at least a mat or rug.
- Food & treats.
- Evidence of up-to-date vaccinations or titer.
- Flat collar with ID tag, leash and any head halter or harness that you use (no flexis/extend-a-leads, choke chains or prong collars, please).

Help us maintain good relations with our training facilities and partner hotels by:

- respecting guidelines and restrictions on number and size of animals per participant/per hotel room;
- safely containing your animal when you are not supervising them;
- leaving the facilities and your hotel room as you found them.

You will be given a printed handout at the workshop. You may want to bring your own notebook for taking notes.

What to Wear: Comfortable clothing for bending, stretching, occasionally sitting on the floor. Dress in layers.

Meals: Meals are not included in the tuition. Water, coffee, tea, and light snacks are provided at the training facility. There is a 75-minute break each day for lunch.
